
To the Honorable, the City Council:

I have previously advised your Honorable Body regarding the change in zoning as it relates to the parcel of land off of Aberdeen Avenue in Cambridge.

I should like your Honorable Body to know that I have talked briefly again today with Mr. Kenneth DeMay from the office of Sasaki, Dawson and DeMay Associates, Architects in Watertown, regarding their intentions on the Aberdeen Avenue site. I have been advised that it is their present plan to remain at their present locus providing that certain considerations might be realized. If these considerations can not be satisfied, it is my understanding that this architectural firm will pursue more vigorously their relocation efforts onto the Aberdeen Avenue site.

Recognizing the previously cited concerns of the residents and realizing the position of all parties, at that point in time, I would recommend that your Honorable Body leave this particular matter on the table pending a resolution of the future occupants.
