- WHEREAS: Sister Rita Karkar of the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Dorothy, was one of the 543 graduates, and as the graduating student with the highest academic standing delivered the Valedictorian Address at the graduation ceremony; and
- WHEREAS: More than two-thirds of the student enrollment at Bethlehem University are women. Among the graduates were four students with visual impairment; now therefore be it
