WHEREAS:-

The City of Cambridge has entered into several contracts with various milk companies for our schools and our institutions and the price of milk is of paramount importance since it constitutes a large expenditure of public funds, therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the City Solicitor to conduct a study of all milk contracts presently in effect in our schools and hospital and take whatever action is necessary in order to insure that the City is not being overpriced by the milk distributors, and be it further

ORDERED:-

That a copy of this order be sent to the Consumers Division of the Attorney General's Office with the request that they investigate this matter and report their findings to the City Council at the earliest possible date.
