Be it ordained by the City Council of the City
of Cambridge, as follows:

Sec. 1. The Superintendent of the Cambridge Water
Works is hereby authorized to pay, from time
to time, from moneys in his hands, any sums
which may become due for the labor of work-
men temporarily employed by him, the amount
of such payments to be subsequently carried
out upon the usual Pay-Rolls, and approved
by the Water Board, and the Committee on Ac-
counts, as provided by the sixth section of the
Ordinance to which this Ordinance is in ad-
dition.

Sec. 2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances
