- WHEREAS: Ken has served his country with distinction as a Captain in the United States Army and held a position of Intelligence Officer during the Viet Nam War, and during this assignment, was awarded the Bronze Star; and
- WHEREAS: Ken Simmons is also an Attorney-at-Law, having been admitted to the Bar of Massachusetts and the Federal Bar and the United States Supreme Court and serves as a member of the Board of Directors of the Cambridge, Arlington and Belmont Bar Association; and
- WHEREAS: Ken has been extremely helpful in the motivation of scouting in Cambridge, always having young people's concerns at heart, no matter if it is a scouting issue or a personal family concern, he is always willing to listen and help; now therefore be it
