

City of Cambridge.

In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred
and Seventy-nine.

An Ordinance in relation to
Shades and Awnings.

Be it ordained, by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge, as follows,

Sect. 1. No canopy, awning, shade, shade frame or
shade-curtain, unless constructed of cloth
or canvas, attached to an iron frame securely
fastened and supported from above, and not
less than eight feet above the level of
the sidewalk over which it is placed, shall
hereafter be erected or maintained within
the limits of any street without permission
of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen.

Sect. 2. Any person violating this Ordinance
shall be liable to a fine of not exceeding
Twenty Dollars.

Sect. 3. The Ordinance in relation to Shades
and Awnings, approved January 1, 1879, is
hereby repealed.
