WHEREAS:-

Blauer Manufacturing Co., Inc., 131 Beverly Street, Boston, Massachusetts are a clothing firm manufacturing police and firemen's and other uniform rainwear, and have been under contract with the International Ladies Garment Workers Union, Local 24 for more than twenty years, and

WHEREAS:-

Blauer has refused to sign a new contract but instead has transferred its productive facilities to other states where they have been operating on a non-union basis, has abolished the jobs of these local manufacturing employees and has been on strike for the last six months, now therefore be it

RESOLVED:-

That the City of Cambridge and its various departments shall not purchase from any distributor any products manufactured by Blauer until Blauer reopens its Boston shop and reemploys its former employees, and further that city employees who have a clothing allowance are hereby urged not to purchase clothing made by Blauer.
