Please be advised that our office has investigated your complaint filed on the Harvard Square Sports Bar incident of November 23, 1991.

After assigning this complaint to Officer Michael McMahon, he spoke with the police officers involved and with the Harvard Police.

The results of the investigation show that the incident happened 10 minutes after the Sports Bar was closed. No patrons were observed in the area at the time. Only employees were in the Sports Bar at the time. The Cambridge police and the Harvard police can not connect the Sports Bar to the incident.

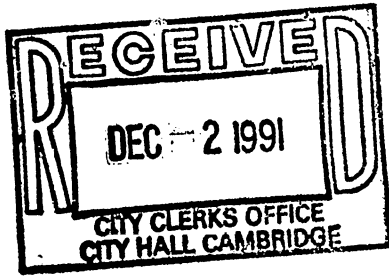
Therefore, we have deemed that no action will be taken on this matter. We will continue to observe this establishment very closely have we have stated in the past. At present, the Sports Bar is closed, serving their 15 day suspension until February 3, 1992.

According to police reports, two arrests were made outside the Harvard Sports Club Bar at 59 J.F. Kennedy Street on Saturday morning November 23 at 2:46 a.m. (reported by police at 3:40 a.m. on November 23, 1991). According to police reports the altercation began in front of the Harvard Sports Club Bar at 59 J.F. Kennedy Street. I was an eyewitness to the arrests. As such I would like to request a hearing to ascertain if the persons involved and charged with assault with a deadly weapon on a police officer and assault with a deadly weapon (two individuals were sent to the hospital) came from the Harvard Sports Club Bar, and to articulate before the License Commission my concerns for the ongoing problem of unrest in my area.
