I take pleasure in appointing you as the State Member of the Cambridge Housing Authority for a term which will expire on November 25, 1978.

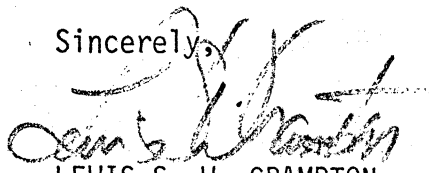
A Certificate of Appointment is enclosed for your records. In order for you to make your appointment final, it will be necessary for you to:

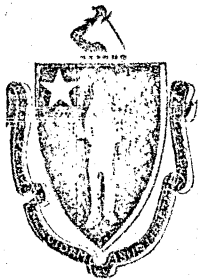
1. Take your Certificate of Appointment to the Office of the Town Clerk and take your oath of office before him; and

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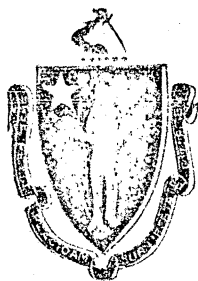
