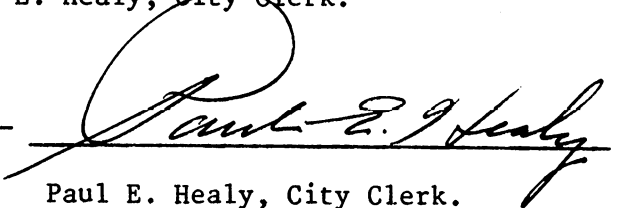
COUNCILLOR WALTER SULLIVAN
