To owners of property in the vicinity of Gannett House,
adjacent to 1511 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge Common
Historic District:

The Cambridge Historical Commission has received from Harvard
Law School an application for a Certificate of Appropriateness
for the following exterior alterations to the property lo-
cated adjacent to 1511 Massachusetts Avenue, known as Gannett
House:

Removal of existing screen tracks; installation of
Humphrey Combination storm and screen windows. Black
Aluminum where black sash occurs. White fixed frames
over side lights and fan lights at front and back
doors. Black Aluminum frames to be mounted on the
inside edges of white window casings as discussed
with the Commission on the site.

Under the provisions of the Historic District Act, General
Laws Chapter 40 C, Section 12, the Cambridge Historical Com-
mission may dispense with a public hearing on this application
and proceed to issue a Certificate of Appropriateness for the
proposed alterations, provided that the alterations are deemed
to be insubstantial in their effect on the Historic District
and that ten days' prior notice is given to the owners of
adjoining property and of property deemed to be materially
affected by such alterations. We deem the effect of the al-
terations described above to be insubstantial and your
property to be among those materially affected.

Should you have any objection to the issuance of a Certificate
of Appropriateness for the proposed alterations at Gannett
House, please notify the Cambridge Historical Commission at
the above address within ten days.
