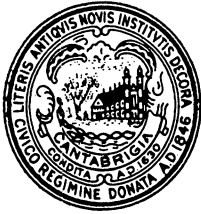

To the Honorable, the City Council:


It is respectfully requested that the following transfer be made in the Municipal Election Budget -

From:	Salaries & Wages	\$5,031.00
To:	Other Ordinary Maintenance	\$5,031.00

This transfer is necessary due to increased costs during the recent counting of the Municipal Election ballots. These increased costs were due to the following reasons: 1) because a new floor at the Longfellow School was installed, a new wooden railing had to be installed and sandbags purchased to support it; 2) many polling places increased the rent, and 3) no provisions had been made in the budget for the printing of a Referendum Ballot on Beano.

Passage of the attached orders is recommended.
