To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$70,443 from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health to the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$34,255), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$29,688), and Travel and Training Account (\$6,500) to provide funds for a Tobacco Control Coalition for the City of Cambridge.

The Cambridge Tobacco Control Coalition will assess community needs and engage in community education, community mobilization and policy setting activities.

Specifically, the Tobacco Control Coalition will: develop and implement a needs assessment; develop a clearinghouse/resource center for current literature, research and prevention efforts; develop and "import" materials that are appropriate and sensitive to linguistic minority communities, persons from communities of color, women and youth; promote community awareness of Cambridge ordinances; develop promotional activities and a media campaign focused on "the benefits" of being smoke free; support and develop cessation and "after-smoking" support groups with easy accessibility for those who wish to stop smoking or who are in fear of relapse; conduct outreach and recruitment activities for sustaining effort and momentum; and sponsor forums and informational meetings related to tobacco.

The Tobacco Control Coalition will implement these objectives not only on a city-wide effort, but intends to work with specific neighborhood groups to incorporate in their agenda tobacco prevention, intervention or educational activities so that the activities will be reflective and sensitive to cultural norms.
