ORDERED: That the following transfer be made in the General Fund of the City of Cambridge:



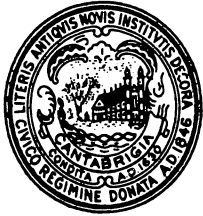


To the Honorable, the City Council:

The attached transfer of \$3,000 to the Executive Department is to enable the Cambridge Animal Commission to carry out programs already begun. Programs include:

- Contacting local veterinarians about establishment of a low cost spaying and neutering program
- Exploring the possibility of having dogs licensed through the Cambridge Animal Commission
- Conducting a City-wide dog census with the help of the Cambridge Election Commission and the Cambridge Police Department
- Drawing up plans to introduce a proposal for the leashing and curbing of dogs
- Beginning to look at ways to solve the problem of dog feces on Cambridge streets
