IN CITY COUNCIL

November 5, 1979

WHEREAS:

Manuel G. Travers, a former employee of the Fire Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Fire Department on December 2, 1928 and was pensioned on July 12, 1952 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 81A and Section 81B of the General Laws and died on February 1, 1979, having served not less than twenty-three years; and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor his widow, Mrs. Concetta Travers, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law; therefore be it

ORDERED:

That under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 95A of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Manuel G. Travers, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Concetta Travers, widow of Manuel G. Travers, of \$3,000.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.




