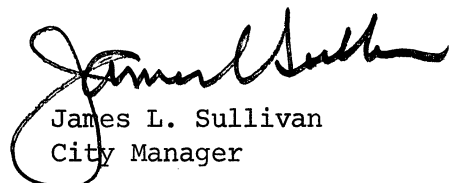

To the Honorable, the City Council:

In response to Council Order No. 7 dated October 4, 1976, requesting a written policy regarding temporary sidewalk information permits, I submit the following policy which will be effective immediately:

1. The Commissioner of Public Works issues all permits for sidewalk tables for the dissemination of information or similar purpose, subject to the approval of the abutter.
2. The Commissioner reserves the right to require the approval of other City Departments including, but not limited to, Police, Fire, Traffic and Parking, and Building Departments.
3. The Commissioner has the right to require a substitute location if, in his or another department's opinion, the proposed location is unsuitable for public safety reasons.
4. All requests for permits must be submitted to the Commissioner at least 72 hours in advance of the date requested.
5. The Commissioner of Public Works reserves the right to restrict the times of the requested tables.
6. The permit holder is subject to all the Massachusetts General Laws and Ordinances of the City of Cambridge, and the City retains the right to revoke said permit for any violation of the above.
