John Gurry of Cambridge, a typesetter, died Sunday after a brief illness at Youville Hospital in Cambridge. He was 59.

Mr. Gurry was a lifelong resident of Cambridge. He was a typesetter at The Boston Globe for many years.

Mr. Gurry is survived by a cousin, Carol Smith of Abington; an aunt, Alice M. Hurley of Arlington; and numerous cousins.

A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 9 a.m. tomorrow at St. John's Church in Cambridge.

Burial will be in Mount Auburn Cemetery, Cambridge.

John Gurry was born in Cambridge to the late John B. Gurry and Mary Madeline (Mahoney) Gurry and was a longtime resident of this city. He worked as a typesetter at the Boston Globe and was a member of the Cambridge French Club.

Mr. Gurry died Sunday, June 29, 1997 at Youville Hospital. He was 59 years old and had experienced a brief illness.
