- WHEREAS: Our Cambridge Public Library is a member of the Eastern Regional System, this voluntary organization which was formed to make available the combined resources of more than 200 public libraries serving the 180 cities and towns in Eastern Massachusetts; and
- WHEREAS: The Eastern Massachusetts Library System is committed to the improvement of library service by providing benefits such as inter-library loan, reference information, films, supplementary collections of reading materials, resource sharing by the use of automated support systems; and
- WHEREAS: Numerous citizens of Eastern Massachusetts, be they business people, workers, students of all ages, indeed, every segment of our communities benefit from these services in their pursuit of information, education and recreation; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council share with the Governor of the Commonwealth, Michael S. Dukakis, and commend October, 1986, as

Eastern Regional Library System Month

and urge all citizens to express appreciation to the librarians and trustees of the Cambridge Public Library and the personnel of the member libraries for their efforts to promote library services; and be it further

- RESOLVED: That the Acting City Clerk prepare a duly engrossed copy of this Resolution and transmit same to the Director of the Cambridge Public Library for display in the Main Library.
