To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$68,968.75 in the Grant Fund from the Human Services Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to Human Services Salary and Wages Account. The Department of Human Services Program administers nearly 3 million dollars in grants and contracts for various programs. Many of these grants include indirect, administrative or overhead allocations which are retained by the department for the purpose of offsetting expenses related to grants management. This transfer is moving such indirect funds into salaries and wages to pay the personnel costs of the fiscal grants assistant who prepares all grant reports, billing and financial statements and who monitors all fiscal activity for DHSP grants. The position is totally funded through indirect grant monies. This transfer will provide for approximately two years of salary and benefits for this position.
