That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to **The County Bank** for the erection of a sign at **12 Norfolk Street, Cambridge.**

Provided that, before erecting the above named sign, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of **Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00)** conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said sign.

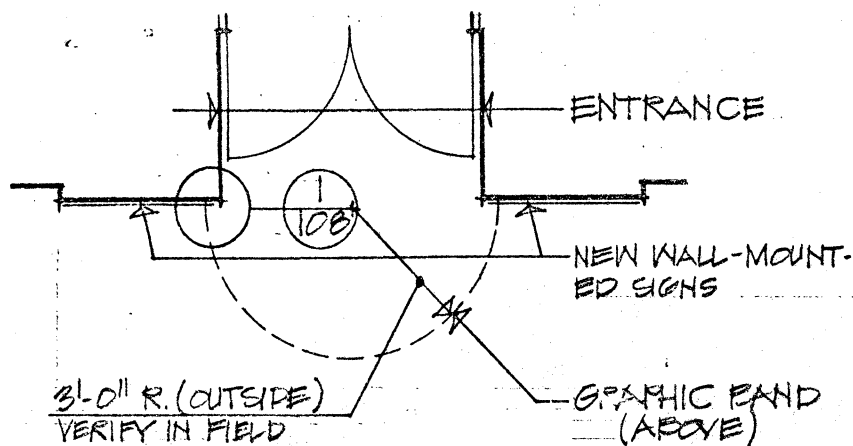

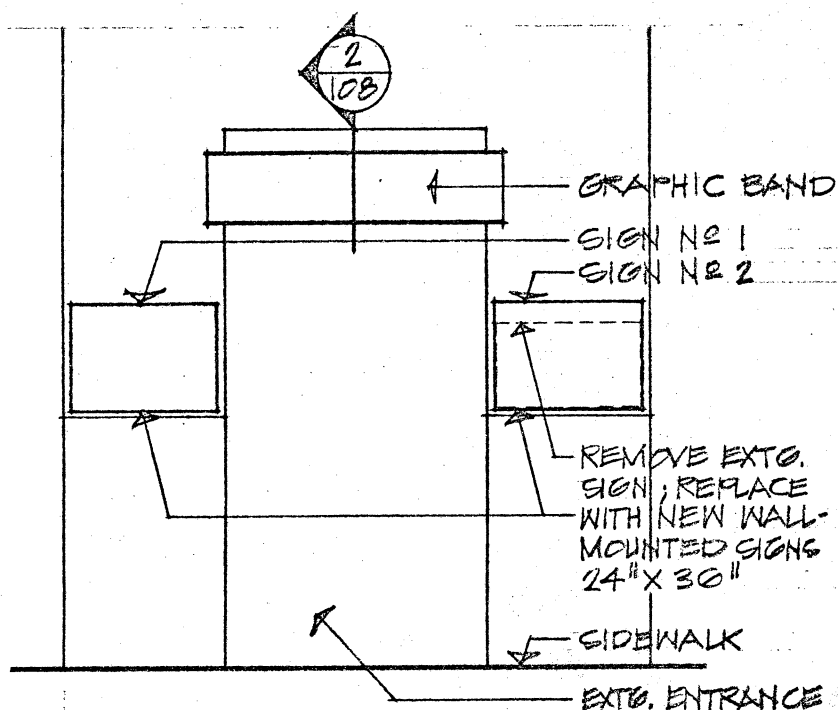

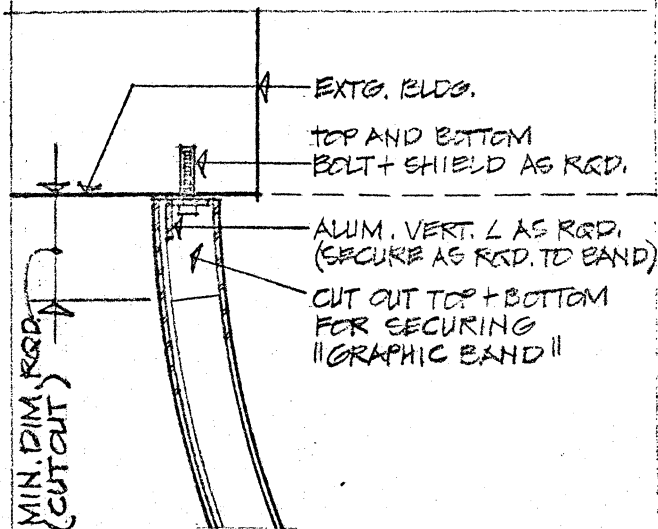


NORFOLK ST. ELEV.

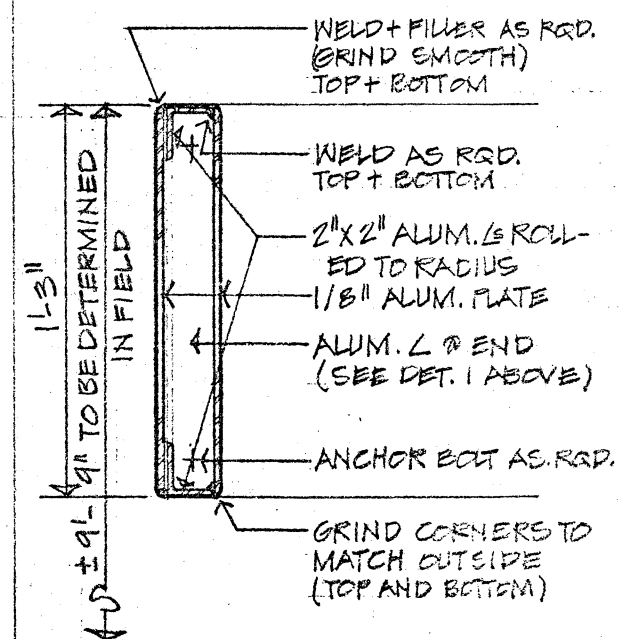
