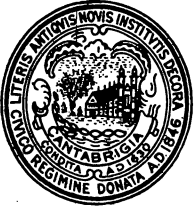

Dear Sir:

I am enclosing two bills totaling \$1,541.00 representing the burial expenses of firefighter John A. Clark who was killed in the line of duty while working a fire on Tufts Street, Cambridge.

Under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100G, the City Council by majority vote with the approval of the City Manager may pay the reasonable expenses not exceeding \$2,000.00 for the funeral and burial of any firefighter who dies in the performance of his duties.

If you approve of this course of action, may I suggest that the appropriate order be prepared for submission to the City Council.

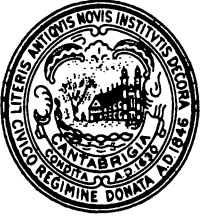


To the Honorable, the City Council:
