City Council Order #16 of Jan. 17, 1977

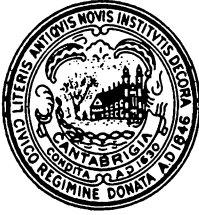

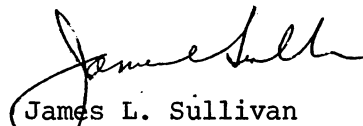
