ORDERED:-

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Superintendent of Streets be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Bernard E. Hill doing business under the name of Hill Hardware Co. for the erection of a sign at No. 2014 Massachusetts Avenue.

Provided that before erecting the above named sign the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said sign.
