On Thursday, February 14, 1980 President Don Orton and I met with City Councilor Alfred Vellucci and Richard McKinnon, the Administrative Assistant to the Cambridge City Council. Claire Olson from the Walnut Street Center joined us for part of the session.

During the meeting we explored the possibilities, requirements and conditions for providing a site at Lesley College for an adult community center.

Because Lesley College provides preservice and inservice education and training programs for teachers and human services professionals we are interested in the Walnut Street Center's project. The need for adult community centers is well documented and this effort is highly valued.

On Monday, February 18 I met with the College's Vice President for Financial Affairs, John Tucker, and President Orton. Together we reviewed our properties and buildings to see if we could provide a site which would meet the Center's needs. I also checked out the availability and price of a site with a private source.

I am sorry to report that Lesley College cannot at this time provide or offer a site which will meet the requirements of the Center.

I hope that this project can be realized. Lesley College will assist in any way it can.
