I leave with you my prayers for continued success, strength and good health.

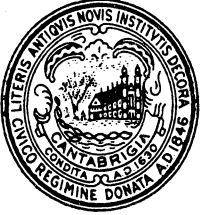

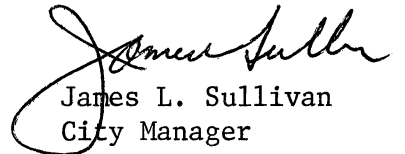
