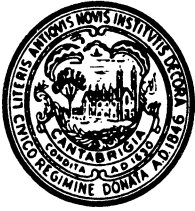

To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 12, regarding a report on the number of minorities interviewed for the Traffic, Community Development, Water and Public Works Departments, the following information is provided:

One hundred and seventy-six applications were received for the Commissioner of Public Works position. Eight candidates were interviewed, two of those candidates were minorities. The same applicant pool was used to select the Managing Director of the Water Department.

For the position of Director of Traffic, Parking and Transportation, ninety-three applications were received. Eleven candidates were interviewed, based upon the recommendations of a seven person citizen panel. One of those candidates was a minority.

For the position of Assistant City Manager for Community Development, forty-three applications were received. An eight person citizen panel recommended the candidates for interview. Five were interviewed, none of whom were minorities.
