Dear Mr. Sullivan:

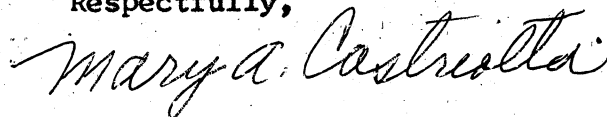
I hereby notify you, that effective immediately, I am resigning as a Commissioner of the Cambridge Housing Authority. This action is being taken, upon the advice of my physician.

Upon my appointment to the Authority, in November of 1970, I was in good health, but with some physical problems. Since that time, however, due to the pressure and duties of my position, both as a Member and as Chairlady, which have grown and grown, my health has suffered.

The pre-existing condition of my health has been aggravated to such an extent that I have been hospitalized many times, and am presently hospitalized. Therefore, unable to continue with my duties, due to the physical and mental damage caused to me, by my membership on the Cambridge Housing Authority, I must tender my resignation.
