COUNCILLOR WYLIE

ORDERED: That in order to reduce hardship and danger attendant upon the new temporary bus stops located at the Cambridge Common, the City Manager is hereby requested to accomplish the following things:

- 1) Review the feasibility of leveling the brick sidewalk between Appian Way and Garden Street so that ice and snow will not create undo danger to elderly persons walking between bus stops on the Common and Harvard Square;
- 2) Erect a large visible danger sign at the head of the Common so that vehicles turning west onto Garden Street will not imperil pedestrians by bearing down on them at a fairly high rate of speed; and
- 3) Negotiate with the M.B.T.A. to provide enclosed bus shelters on the Common prior to the cold weather.
