IN CITY COUNCIL

June 29, 1981

ORDERED: That in accordance with the provision of the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge, Chapter Three, Section 3-2, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to the Cambridge Cooperative Corporation, doing business as Cambridge Food Co-Op for the purpose of displaying and selling merchandise on the sidewalk in front of the premises numbered 580 Massachusetts Avenue from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. Tuesday through Friday and 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday from June 30, 1981 to November 30, 1981 provided that no such permit shall be granted to exceed more than twenty-five percent of the width of the sidewalk from the property line of the premises in front of which said display shall be installed and provided further that before erecting the above named display, the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said display.
