WHEREAS:- The Parrish Council of St. Paul's Church has recently voted to have the City demolish the ten classrooms on the Church property pursuant to the terms of the City's agreement with said Church,

WHEREAS:- The Highland Park Free School of 42 Hawthorne Street, Roxbury, Massachusetts, has indicated they would be willing to purchase said classrooms at a minimum cost if they were able to move them from their present location,

WHEREAS:- The Highland Park Free School has received communication from Senator Edward E. Brooke who has asked the Army Corps of Engineers to remove said portable classrooms and re-erect them as a community service in Roxbury,

ORDERED:- That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to refrain from taking any steps to demolish said classrooms until it can be determined that they cannot relocate to another site by the Highland Park Free School.
