Edward A. Handy, Cambridge Transit Coordinator has been notified that on Tuesday evening, August 24, 1971 at 7:30 o'clock in the Arlington Town Hall, Arlington Center, a meeting open to the public will be held by the Governor's Transportation Planning Review Committee to review the:

Inner Belt (Cambridge and Somerville);

Route 2 Extension from Alewife to Inner Belt;

Western Corridor from Route 2 to Mass Turnpike;

Harvard Alewife subway extension.

Since these all-inclusive subjects cannot possibly be discussed at length at this meeting of representatives of the so-called Northwest Corridor Communities, no one attending should anticipate a decision to be announced on any one of the subjects.

However, it is planned to include on the agenda these specific items:

Establishment of a working committee to represent the communities;

Presentation of the first draft of issues to be studied by the

Governor's Planning Review Committee in this area;

Report on the status of the deep-bore tunnel study for the

Harvard-Alewife subway extension.

It is expected that the public will obtain full information on the work of the Planning Review Group which is only really getting under way, the consultant's contract having been executed only recently.
