- WHEREAS: This City Council was saddened upon learning of the death of Helen Agnes Clauss, a life long Cantabrigian and retired Purchasing Agent for the City of Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Helen attended local schools and first began her public service career on June 10, 1946 as a Clerk-Typist in the Cambridge School Department, and through the years held several positions of varying responsibility, including being appointed as Purchasing Agent for the entire School Department, a position from which she retired on August 30, 1976, completing thirty years of dedicated service to the City of Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Helen had long been active in civic and charitable affairs, serving as a member of Saint Mary's Sodality, Vice-President of Saint Mary's Legion of Mary Praesidia, as well as being a Past President of the Sen Fu Mission Club and was a Director of the Youville Hospital Guild; and
- WHEREAS: Helen was a person who always made herself available to people and organizations which provide assistance to the sick and infirm, never taking her personal needs or considerations into account; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Edward (Luberta) Shay and to the entire Clauss family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family on behalf of the entire City Council.
