WHEREAS: The year 1992 marks the 500th anniversary of Christopher Columbus's arrival in America, an event which has profoundly affected our lives and culture; and

WHEREAS: Every city in the country has been notified to coordinate commemorative events in honor of this quincentennial; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting that Cambridge join the rest of the world in celebrating the 500th anniversary of this historic occasion; and

WHEREAS: The Mayor has appointed Alfred E. Vellucci to formalize a committee to address ways in which the Cambridge community can take note of and participate in the Columbian Quincentennial; and

WHEREAS: With the organization of a large scale festival such as this, every department and organization in the City should be invited to assist; and

WHEREAS: The Cambridge Arts Council, as the City's official cultural agency, is experienced in producing festivals and events for the City; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council request the City Manager to explore the possibility of appointing the Cambridge Arts Council to facilitate the Columbian Quincentennial by acting as a coordinating agency for this commemoration.
