Dear Mr. Healy:

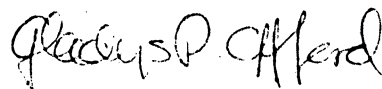

Dear Ms. Lastovica:

I am writing to you on behalf of Walden Street Associates, developers of a new 11 unit townhouse project at 127-133 Walden Street. Per our telephone conversation, I am sending the subdivision plan and survey of this project for your review prior to submitting a petition to the City Council requesting a new designation of the premises. The City Council petition will request that the premises hereafter be known as Walden Mews and that the individual townhouses be numbered 1-11.

It is my understanding that the central driveway of the project is presently considered a private way and does not need City Council approval as such. We would need approval if we wished to have it be declared a public way. In other words, we are just requesting a new designation of an old address and not approval of a private way. Please advise if you think this conclusion is incorrect.

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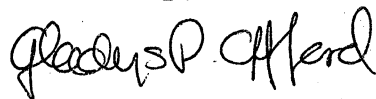
