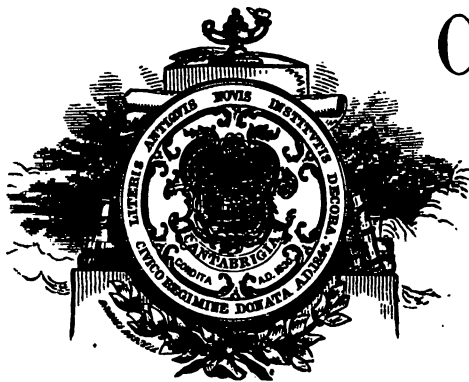




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

June 28 1882

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Henry street, between Pearl and Brookline streets,

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land
in width between

forty feet

Pearl and Brookline streets

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *W. A. Mason*
and *Jan* and dated *May 31. 1882.*

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. *The*
several owners and abutters agreeing to waive the usual
notice of such taking and to release the land required.
