

An Ordinance to establish a
Cemetery Fund.

Be it ordained by the City
Council of the City of Cambridge as follows.

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners of
the Cambridge Cemetery are authorized and
empowered, on behalf of the City, to receive
and accept any sum of money, which any
person may by gift, legacy, payment or other-
wise, give or bequeath to said City, for the
purpose of keeping & preserving in suitable
& proper ~~condition~~ ^{reparation} & preservation any lot
or grave in the said Cambridge Ceme-
tery, - the acceptance of such gift, legacy
or payment to be subject to the approval
of the Mayor & Aldermen of said City - And
when any such acceptance shall have been
made & approved, as aforesaid, such gift, lega-
cy or payment shall be forever appropriated
to the purpose aforesaid by the said City.

Section 2. The said City shall not by virtue
of any such acceptance or receiving of any
such gift, legacy, payment, or sum of money

be holden or obliged to appropriate, or in any way expend, for or in keeping in proper & suitable condition & preservation any grave, tomb, or lot in said cemetery for which ~~the~~ ^{such} sum of money may be given paid or bequeathed as aforesaid, more than the net income of such sum; & all such gifts payments, bequests shall be accepted received upon that condition or limitation

Section 3. All sums accepted received under this ordinance shall be paid over to the City Treasurer for the time being, & by him kept as a distinct fund & called The Cemetery Fund, & the same shall be invested from time to time by the said Treasurer, under direction of the Mayor, in such manner as they may deem expedient. And the said Treasurer shall report, annually, & oftener if thereto required, to the City Council the condition amount & investment of said fund.

Section 4 The net annual income of ~~each~~ ^{as may be} portion of said fund, given by any person, shall be appropriated & expended in keeping in proper & suitable condition & preservation ~~any~~ ^{such} grave, ^{tomb} or lot in said

Cambridge Cemetery, shall be designated
by ~~such person~~ ^{such person} ~~and fund~~ shall be specially given or
bequeathed for, the said ~~lot~~ ^{lot} ~~to~~ ^{to} be in all cases specifically designated, when
said gift or legacy, or payment is made.
If said income shall be more than suf-
ficient for said purpose in any one year
the ~~excess~~ shall be added to the prin-
cipal of that portion of the fund on which
it accrues, until such time as the same
may be necessary for said purpose.
