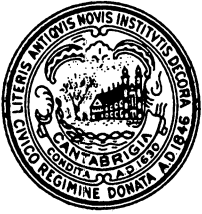


To the Honorable, the City Council:

The attached order decreases the amount of property taxes needed to fund the Police Department by \$250,000.00. The new revenue will come from the Parking Fund.
