Petition of Metropolitan Transit Authority for approval by the Department of the erection, maintenance and use of poles to support the wires of its electrical system.

This is a petition of the Metropolitan Transit Authority under the provisions of section 10 of Chapter 544 of the Acts of 1947 for permission to erect, maintain and use 10 poles in Mount Auburn Street in the city of Cambridge.

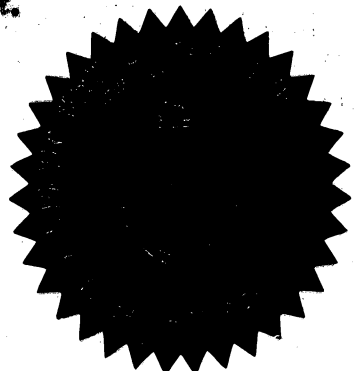
After notice, a public hearing held on October 24, 1958 at which no one appeared in opposition and after consideration, it is

ORDERED: That the Metropolitan Transit Authority be and hereby is granted permission to erect, maintain and use ten poles to support the wires of its electrical system in the city of Cambridge as follows:

Ten (10) poles in Mount Auburn Street from westerly of Coolidge Avenue to and including the junction of Mount Auburn Street with Fresh Pond Parkway and Memorial Drive Extension;

substantially as shown by red dots on plan of James A. O'Neil, Chief Electrical Engineer of the Authority, dated April 1, 1958 and filed with the petition. Also that permission be and hereby is granted to said Authority to attach its wires, appliances and electrical appliances and apparatus to said poles and to make the underground and surface alterations to the street necessary for that purpose, and the Department

DETERMINES the above described grant of location to be in the public interest.

An appeal as to matters of law from any final decision, order or ruling of the commission may be taken to the supreme judicial court by an aggrieved party in interest by the filing of a written petition praying that the order of the commission be modified or set aside in whole or in part.

Such petition for appeal shall be filed with the secretary of the commission within twenty days after the date of the decision, order or ruling of the commission or within such further time as the commission may allow upon request filed prior to the expiration of the twenty days after said decision, order or ruling. 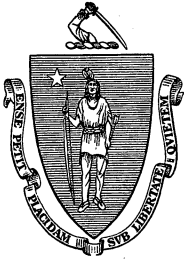

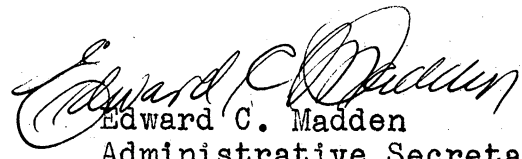

Petition of the Metropolitan Transit Authority for leave to erect, maintain and use poles to support the wires of its electric system as follows:

In Cambridge: Ten (10) poles in Mount Auburn Street from westerly of Coolidge Avenue to and including the junction of Mount Auburn Street with Fresh Pond Parkway and Memorial Drive Extension; substantially as shown by red dots on plan of James A. O'Neil, Chief Electrical Engineer of the Authority, dated August 14, 1958 and filed herewith (said poles to be in place of existing poles as shown by dotted white circles on the aforesaid plan). Also, for permission to attach its wires, appliances and electrical appliances and apparatus to said poles and to make the underground and surface alterations to the street necessary for that purpose.

Upon the foregoing petition the Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing at its hearing room, 166 State House, Boston on Friday, October 24, 1958 at 10:30 o'clock in the forenoon.
