IN CITY COUNCIL

March 14, 1977

WHEREAS:

James J. Shea, a former employee of the Police Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Police Department on March 1, 1929 and was pensioned on May 24, 1963 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 83A, subsection (a) and Section 94, of the General Laws and died on December 7, 1976, having served not less than thirty-three years, and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Margaret Shea, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That, under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 95A of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by James J. Shea, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Margaret Shea, widow of James J. Shea, of \$3,000.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.
