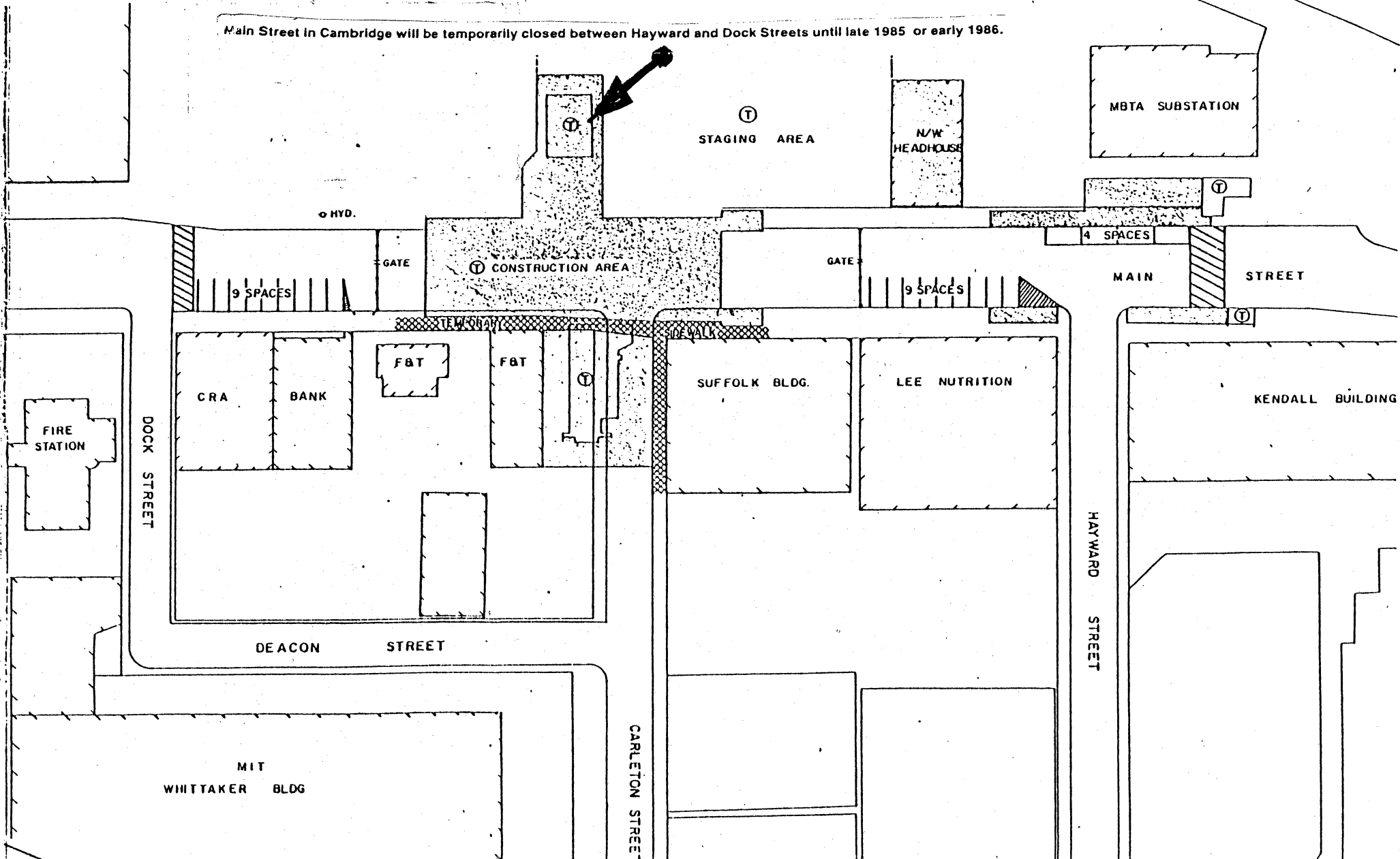

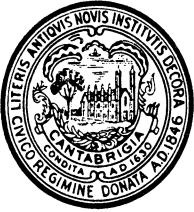

A short section of Main Street will be closed to vehicles while the train platform in the Kendall Square station is lengthened.

Main Street in Cambridge will be temporarily closed between Hayward and Dock Streets until late 1985 or early 1986.

To the Honorable, the City Council:

I have been notified by George Teso, Director of Traffic and Parking, that a portion of Main Street in the Kendall Square area, between Dock and Hayward Streets, will be closed to through traffic on or about Wednesday, June 13, 1984.

This action is necessitated by the start of construction work on the rehabilitation and extension of the Kendall Square station, a multi-million dollar MBTA project expected to take approximately 20 months.

The closing of the street has been discussed at length with the businessmen in the area, the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority and M.I.T. The street closing has been approved by the Fire and Police Departments and the Public Works Department. Properly posted signs related to new traffic circulation and emergency vehicle access in the area will be provided.
