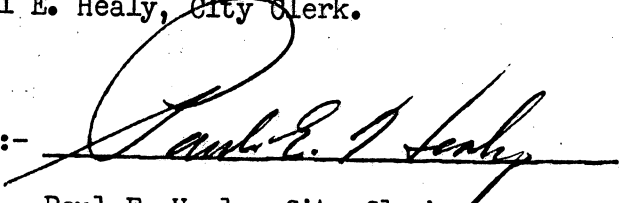
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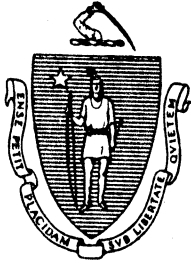

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-

AN ACT

AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE TO CHARGE CERTAIN FEES
FOR LICENSES FOR AUTOMATIC AMUSEMENT DEVICES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1.

Notwithstanding section 177A of chapter 140 of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the city of Cambridge may by ordinance establish the initial fee for a license for an automatic amusement device at an amount not greater than three thousand dollars, and for the annual renewal thereof, at an amount not greater than one thousand.



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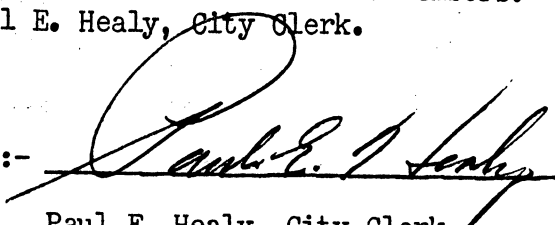
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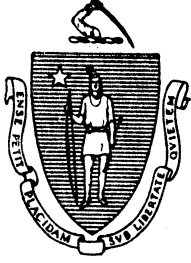
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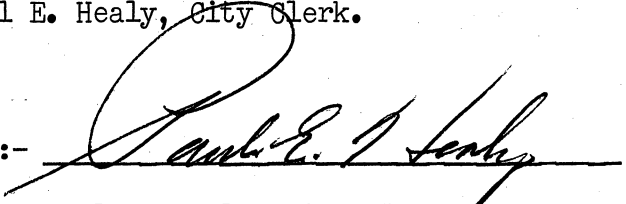
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
