

The attached transfer of \$5,671.50 from the Commission on the Status of Women's Budget - \$1,165.00 from Salary & Wages and \$4,506.50 from Travel and Training - into its Other Ordinary Maintenance Account is needed for several projects:

2,000.00 to produce a photographic exhibit on women in Cambridge history


1,200.00 for a consultant to evaluate services to women provided by women's organizations and human services agencies
