COUNCILLOR WOLF

- WHEREAS: The building of the Seabrook Nuclear power plants has now resulted in a financial disaster; and
- WHEREAS: Consumers in Cambridge were not part of the decision-making process of Seabrook's investors and management, and, in fact, many protested the construction; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That Cambridge Electric Company, a subsidiary of Commonwealth Energy, a shareholder in the Seabrook venture, be requested by this City Council to reject the notion of any electric power rate increase to Cambridge consumers caused by the Seabrook debacle; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That Cambridge Electric and Commonwealth Energy are hereby requested to fight against any such attempt to pass on these business errors to consumers; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Chief Executive officer of Cambridge Electric and Commonwealth Energy, and to the head of the State Department of Public Utilities.
