Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 28, Regulation of Traffic - Article III, Section 4, Location of Bus Stops, trackless trolley stops, taxicab stands and service zones. The Metropolitan Transit Authority is hereby given permission to move the present inbound bus and trackless trolley stopping place on Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge, from the near side of Rice Street, to the far side of Norris Street, to start at Norris Street and to extend 65 feet easterly, and to erect two stanchions with signs reading "Trackless Trolley and Bus Stop- No Parking."


