The Committee on Roads and Bridges to whom was referred the petition of Edward Cassidy et al that Lopez St, in Ward IV, may be reopened to public travel, and, also the communication of the Superintendent of Streets in relation thereto, would report that they have considered the same. They find that the street is in a very dangerous condition and unsafe for public travel, and that the action of the Superintendent of Streets in closing it was perfectly right and proper. They further find that no attempt has been made by the abutters to repair the same, and they would therefore recommend that the petitioners be granted leave to withdraw.
