I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$75,000.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$55,357.00), the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$7,100.00) and the Travel and Training Account (\$12,543.00). The Massachusetts Department of Education has awarded the Community Learning Center funds through a Young Adults with Learning Disabilities grant. Funds will be used to train teachers to work with learning disabled students, will cover a portion of the salaries of two full time teachers, two full time support staff, program operating expenses, and required conference attendance.
