We are impacted by the exhaust of diesel fumes and the noisy motors. Busses wait with their motors idling. In our building there are young children, others with asthma and chronic lung problems, not to mention the elderly, all of whom shouldn't have to breathe these unhealthy fumes. The exhaust from the busses prevent us from opening our windows.

Since the bus stop areas in Central Square have been reduced or compromised, MBTA drivers are now often forced to wait in residential areas. Many times these areas are posted. Busses had not parked there previously. We request your immediate attention and help in resolving this growing problem.

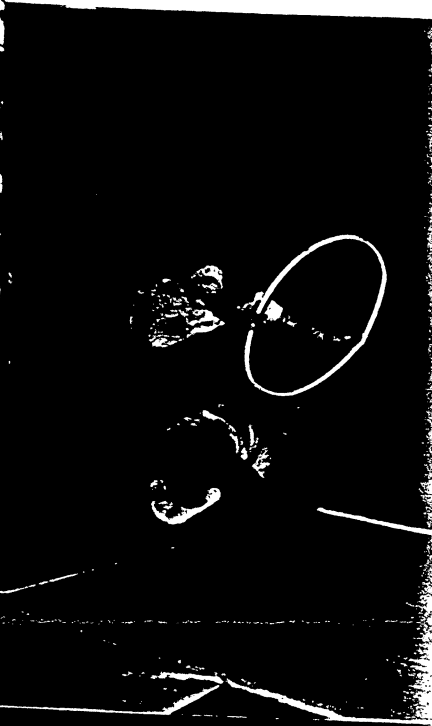

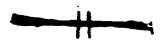
