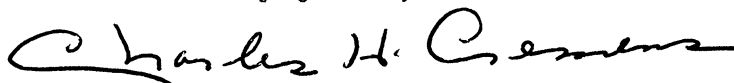
Dear Mr. Corcoran:

You may be assured that the field will be available at 6:00 P.M. and our athletic personnel will cooperate with all agencies concerned.

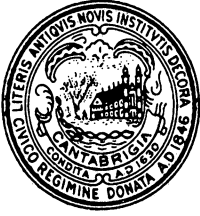
