
Dear Mr. Mills:

Your kind attention in this matter will be greatly appreciated by the City Council.

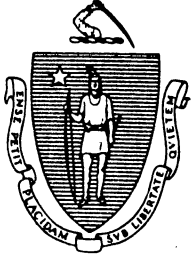

IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF PARKING FINES FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 455 of the Acts of 1961, as most recently amended by chapter of the Acts of 1981, is hereby further amended by adding the following new clause (G):-

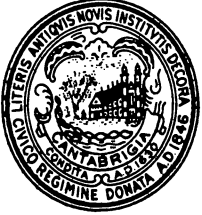
