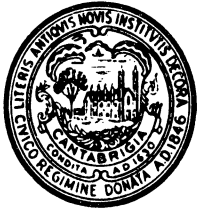
Subject Council Order #7 5/18/87 Resident Parking Use of 2050 Mass. Ave.

The parking spaces in the rear of the L.J. Russell apartments at 2050 Mass. Avenue are under the control of the manager of the building. This is according to Chapter 266 Section 120D of the MGL.

This allows those in lawful control of improved or enclosed property to restrict parking by giving notice by posting signs such as "Parking By Permission Of Owner Others Will Be Towed At Their Expense."

This is the same procedure used to control parking in school and library parking areas.
